Coach & Site Director Notes

ALL INFORMATION IS POSTED BELOW AND WILL BE HANDED OUT ONSIGHT THIS YEAR.

Coaches will begin to meet the site director listed below, one hour before their first game to pick up the Players Ring and information. The information will be marked with your Team Age/Classification and team number. The site director's location is listed below. Most important, at the end of your games if you had a player that was not present you must fill out the form in the bag of rings and return the ring with the name of the player to the Site Director on that form and in that bag. It is the only way we can mail the player his ring. Look for Site Directors at the locations below and do not leave until they have the rings and roster information from missing players. Some ROSTERS have changed since I printed what you have. There may be a player on your roster that is not there because I had a late email that he would not be attending and pulled his ring. Feel free to note that but if short a ring that is probably what happened. I have it and will mail next week.

CB- Fields 1-6Will be in the shade on East side of Middle Concessions by Field 6CB- Fields 5-10Will be in the shade on West side of Middle Concessions by Field 7Lamp FieldsWill be in the shade on East side of the Snack Shack.Dill ComplexWill be in the shade on the West side of the Concessions.

- Coaches, make sure to hand out the Rings as soon as you meet your players. Make sure they get their awards early just in case there were to be weather issues. PLAYERS AND 1 COACH ARE THE ONLY ONES THAT GET RINGS.
- Everyone plays. If player sits out an inning, he is in the next inning. <u>Players bring your own helmet and your own water.</u> <u>We do not keep score!!</u>
- Allow kids to play different positions, perhaps draw names from hat for batting order. Make it fun. If a team bats around during the inning, stop and change sides. If there are extras on a team and with the heat being such a concern, substitute during an inning. Let them come in a get a drink. Take breaks and keep everyone hydrated.
- If we have a player or two does not show and a team is left with less than 9, please check team in other dugout or next to your field for a team that perhaps has 10 or 11 and could give you a player for the 2 games.
- If we have a team that does not have catcher gear, please do the same thing as above. <u>It may be a good idea if you have team catcher gear to bring it along for emergency backup</u>. <u>THE 1 HR. 40 MIN. GAME TIME IS A DROP DEAD GAME LENGTH. Do not extend the game past 1 hr. 40 min.</u>
- If we have a player not show up, please turn their Ring & the Form over to the Site Director listed above. It is very important you do this before leaving. THIS IS CRITICAL. SITE DIRECTORS WILL RETURN IT TO ME AND I WILL MAIL IT OUT. THIS IS THE ONLY WAY I CAN GET THEM THEIR RING.
- <u>Team/Player Introductions each game. Have your team line up on 1st and 3rd base line 6' apart before the game and have them introduce themselves. Coach leads it off to show them how. At the conclusion of the game have them line up again same way as before and together the team will tip their hats to parents in appreciation. We will not shake hands. Thanks this goes a very long way in making the event special.</u>
